

2011 Pricing Information

Duke University Press offers two collections of journals in the humanities and social sciences. Because the number of titles published by Duke is expected to grow from year to year while some libraries need to keep their costs from increasing, we have developed **Standard** and **Expanded** collections to provide options for libraries.

The collections are hosted by HighWire Press at dukejournals.org.

STANDARD

The 2011 **e-Duke Journals Scholarly Collection: Standard** includes online access to 33 Duke humanities and social science journals.

EXPANDED

The 2011 **e-Duke Journals Scholarly Collection: Expanded** includes 38 titles. The number of titles in this collection is expected to increase from year to year as Duke adds more titles.

1. Full-time enrollment (FTE)
2. Degrees offered: associate's, baccalaureate, master's, and/or doctoral

Specialized-institution pricing is available only for institutions that meet the above requirements.

SITE LICENSE AGREEMENT
