***The Collected Letters of Thomas and Jane Welsh Carlyle* Granted 2009 NEH Award**

Duke University Press is proud to announce that *The Collected Letters of Thomas and Jane Welsh Carlyle* has been granted a National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) award for \$200,000. The funds will help cover the costs of publishing three new print volumes between 2010 and 2013.

The Collected Letters of Thomas and Jane Welsh Carlyle offers a window onto the lives of two of the Victorian world's most accomplished, perceptive, and unusual people. The Carlyles attracted a circle of foreign exiles, radicals, feminists, revolutionaries, and writers from across Europe and the United States. The collection is regarded as one of the finest and most comprehensive literary archives about the nineteenth century. The correspondents include Charles Dickens, John Stuart Mill, Elizabeth Gaskell, and Ralph Waldo Emerson.

The *Carlyle Letters Online*, the electronic edition of the letters, is a digital archive that hosts over 10,000 of the Carlyles' collected letters searchable by date, recipient, subject, and volume. In part because of grants from the NEH and the Delmas Foundation, the *Carlyle Letters Online* is currently available at no charge to institutions and individuals.
