NetGalley is an innovative, easy-to-use website that provides digital galleys free of charge to reviewers, media, librarians, booksellers and educators. NetGalley helps reduce our environmental impact while also giving you faster access to our titles.

You're now able to request a digital review copy of great books from Duke University Press in the areas of art, music, gay/lesbian studies, women's studies, history, and travel. Browse Duke University Press titles [here](#).

As a NetGalley user, you'll be among the first reviewers to read our digital galleys—and you have the option to download PDF versions to your computer, read them on your Nook, Kindle, Kobo, Sony Reader, or smartphones with certain free apps, and even search within the galleys.

You can also send your reviews to us within NetGalley, like an electronic tear-sheet. It's easy: Once you've read one of the galleys and written your review, login to your NetGalley account. Click "Manage My Reviews" and then click the "Write" pencil icon; select "Review Completed." Be sure to include the entire review and a link to where it's published; hit SAVE. An email will be sent right to us.

To request a Duke University Press galley, sign up at [www.netgalley.com](http://www.netgalley.com) and search in the catalog. Find a title you like, and click the REQUEST button. Once we approve your request, you'll get an email notification and your digital galley will appear on your NetGalley homepage.
