#### Access Options

##### Purchase

Purchase includes perpetual access to all e-books in the chosen collection. In subsequent years, purchasing libraries will have the option to “top up” their subject collection by buying the year’s new batch of relevant titles.

##### Annual Lease

This option is only available for the Latin American Studies and Gender Studies collections. An annual lease provides one calendar year of access (January to December). To maintain access after 2020, libraries may purchase the collection or renew the lease.

##### Lease to Own

Libraries that lease the Latin American Studies or Gender studies collection for five consecutive years are automatically **upgraded to perpetual access** to the full collection.

##### Access
