### 2017 Pricing information

The Latin American Studies collection includes 529 e-books in anthropology, cultural studies, Caribbean studies, Chicano and Latino studies, history, literature, media, and many other fields, focused on Latin America. Hosted on [read.dukeupress.edu](http://read.dukeupress.edu), the collection is available through outright purchase or one-year lease. Download the title list at [dukeupress.edu/library](http://dukeupress.edu/library).

These e-books are **DRM-free and allow unlimited simultaneous, multiuser access**.

#### Purchase the collection

Purchase includes perpetual access to 529 Latin American Studies e-books. In subsequent years, purchasing libraries will have the option to “top-up” their subject collection by buying the year’s new batch of relevant titles at a discount.

#### Annual lease

Annual lease provides one calendar year of access (January to December 2017) to the Latin American Studies collection. For 2017, this includes 529 titles. To maintain access after 2017, libraries will need to purchase the collection or renew the lease.

#### Lease to own

Libraries that lease the Latin American Studies collection for five years (sequential or nonsequential) are automatically **upgraded to perpetual access** to the collection.
