The **e-Duke Books Scholarly Collection** provides access to over 2,400 e-books published by Duke University Press in the humanities and social sciences. Key subject areas include anthropology, art history and theory, Asian studies, cultural studies, ethnic studies, film and television, gender and sexuality studies, Latin American studies, political theory, and science studies. Libraries that purchase the 2018 collection own perpetual access to at least 100 new e-books released in 2018 and receive term access to all available back titles during the calendar year.
