The e-Duke Books Scholarly Collection provides access to over 2,300 e-books published by Duke University Press in the humanities and social sciences. Libraries that purchase the 2017 collection own perpetual access to at least 100 new e-books released in 2017 and receive term access to all available back titles during the calendar year.
