The **e-Duke Journals Scholarly Collections** provide online access to Duke University Press journals in the humanities and social sciences. For 2018 the **Expanded** collection includes 50 titles. The **Standard** collection includes 44 titles and is available only to renewing customers.

### Features of Both Collections Include

- perpetual access to 2018 content plus term access to all available back issues
- 70% discount on print add-on subscriptions
- searching across all content types, with filters for refinement, and reference linking to e-resources
- e-mail alerts for new issues
- COUNTER-compliant usage statistics
