

e-book sale FAQs

Q: Can I use the account I set up at <http://www.dukeupress.edu> to purchase e-books on the content platform?

A: No, you will need to create a new account at <https://read.dukeupress.edu/> to access and purchase Duke University Press e-books.

Q: What are the dates for the special sale?

A: Individual e-books are available at \$4.99 from February 28, 2019 until March 21, 2019. After that time, you will be able to purchase e-books at the regular rate (equivalent to the paperback price).

Q: Does this sale apply to Duke University Press e-books purchased through Amazon, Kobo, BN.com, and other online retailers?

A: No, this special offer is only available at <https://read.dukeupress.edu>

Q: How will I access the book(s) I purchased online?

A: You will receive a confirmation email with a link to download the book(s) you purchased. Follow the link in the email to access the pdf.

Q: May I print a copy of the book?

A: Downloading, printing, or saving of content for personal, non-commercial use is permissible. No commercial use of any articles is permitted without prior, express written permission of Duke University Press. If you want to use an e-book in courses, your students should purchase an individual copy, access it through your library (if available there), or request permission to photocopy.

Q: Will I have perpetual access to the file?

A: Yes. If you lose the file, you can return to our site and download the book again. Please note that e-books are non-returnable.

Q: I would like to purchase an e-book, but I don't see a buy button. What do I do?

A: If you don't see the option to purchase an e-book, it's likely because your institution's library subscribes to our e-book collection. Books you have access to through your institution will feature a green check mark by the title. Download the chapters you want at no charge and thank your librarian for subscribing!
